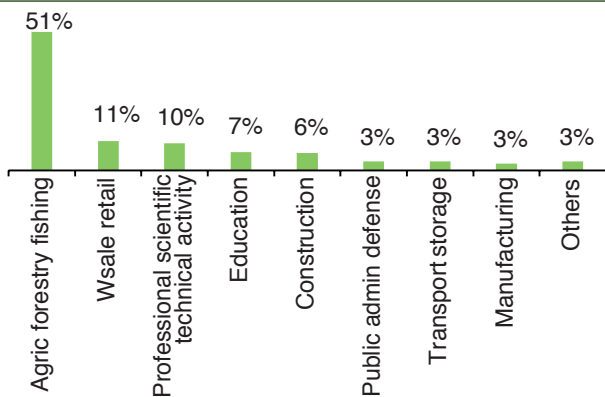
### Sector Contribution to Total County GCP (%)



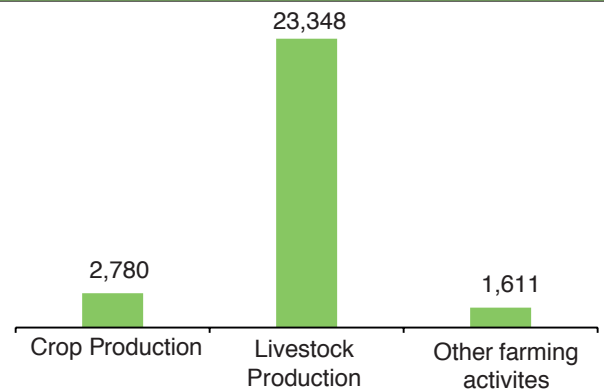
### Average County Sector Contribution to overall sector Gross value Added (GVA) (%)



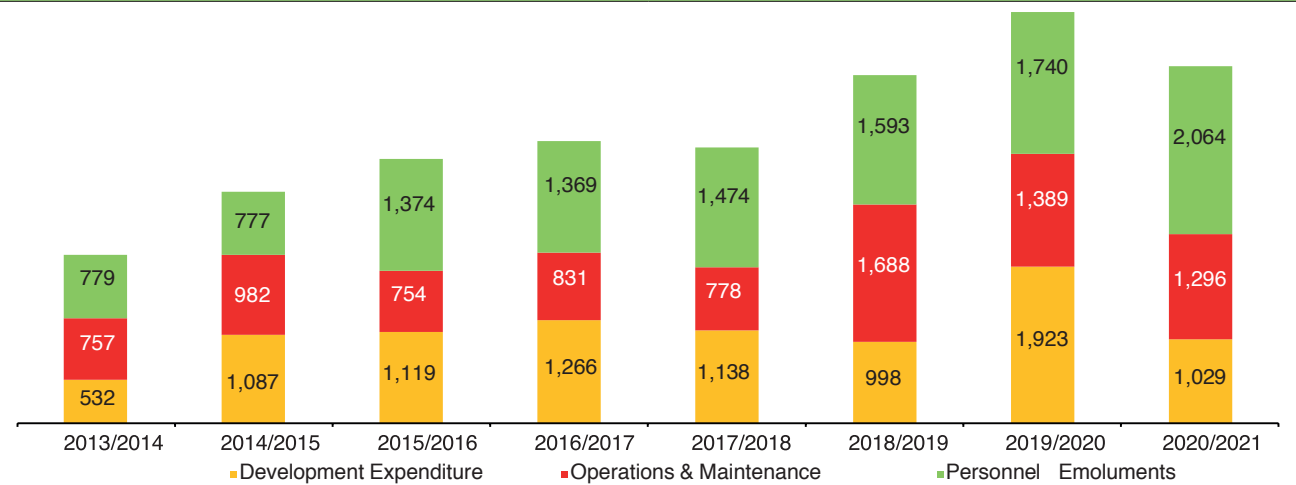
### Percent of Population Engaged in Economic Activities by Sector as at 2015/16

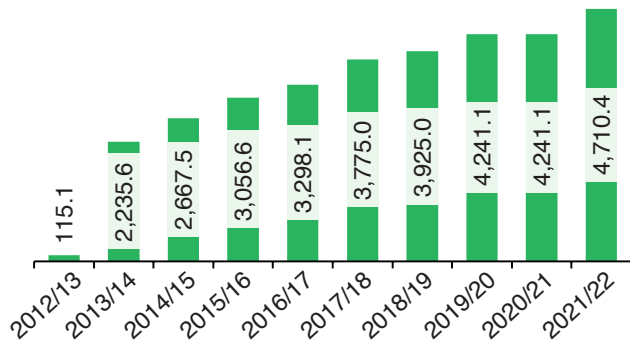

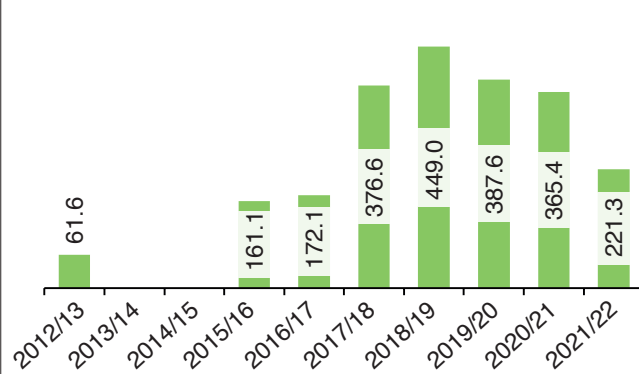

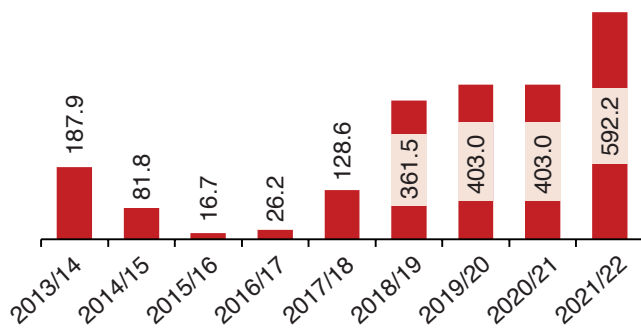
### Equitable share (Ksh. million)



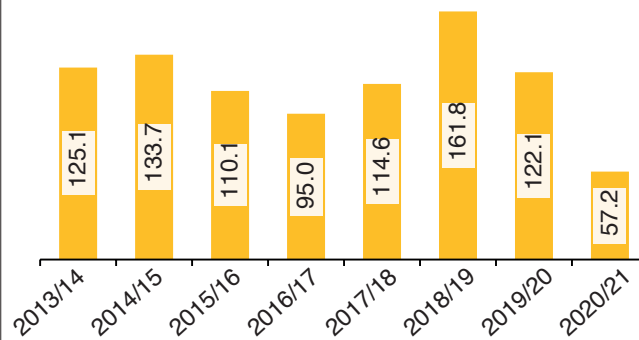
### National Government Conditional Grants (Ksh. million)



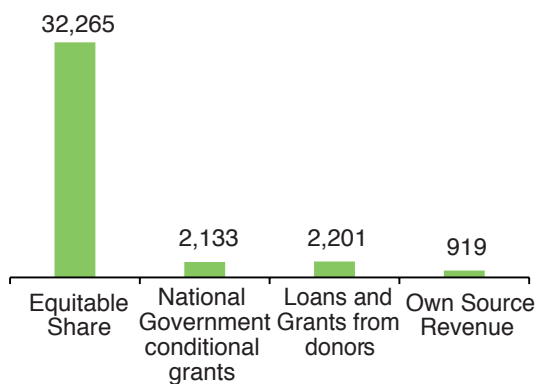
### Donor Loans and Grants (Ksh. million)

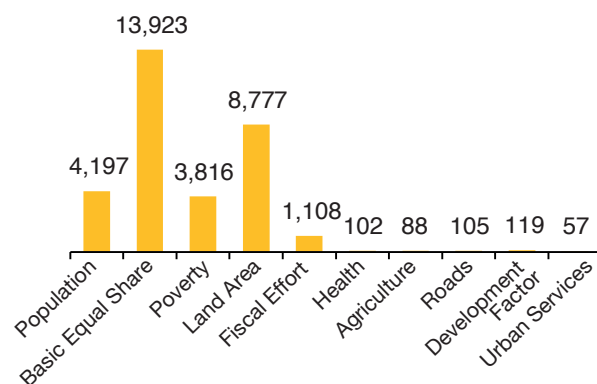


## Total County Revenues for FY 2012/13 - 2021/22\* (Ksh. million)
