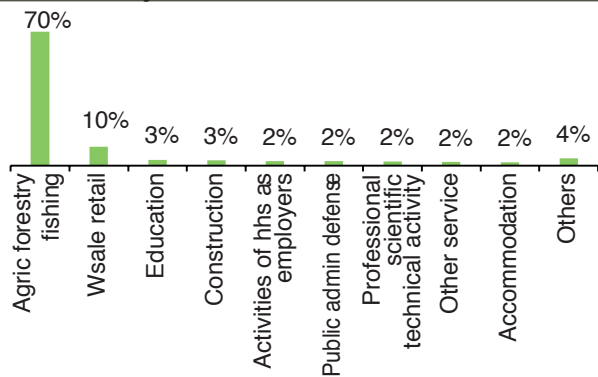
Sector Contribution to Total County GCP (%)



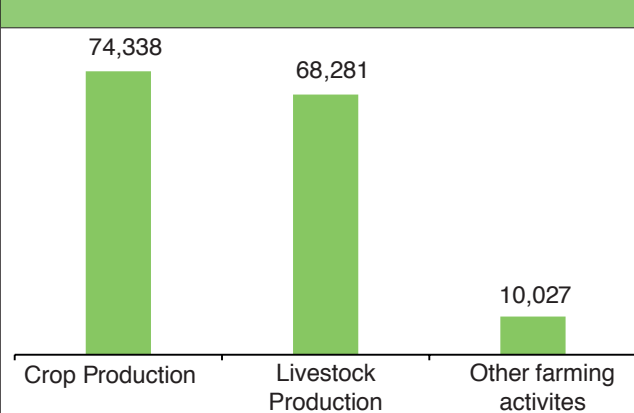
Average County Sector Contribution to overall sector Gross value Added (GVA) (%)



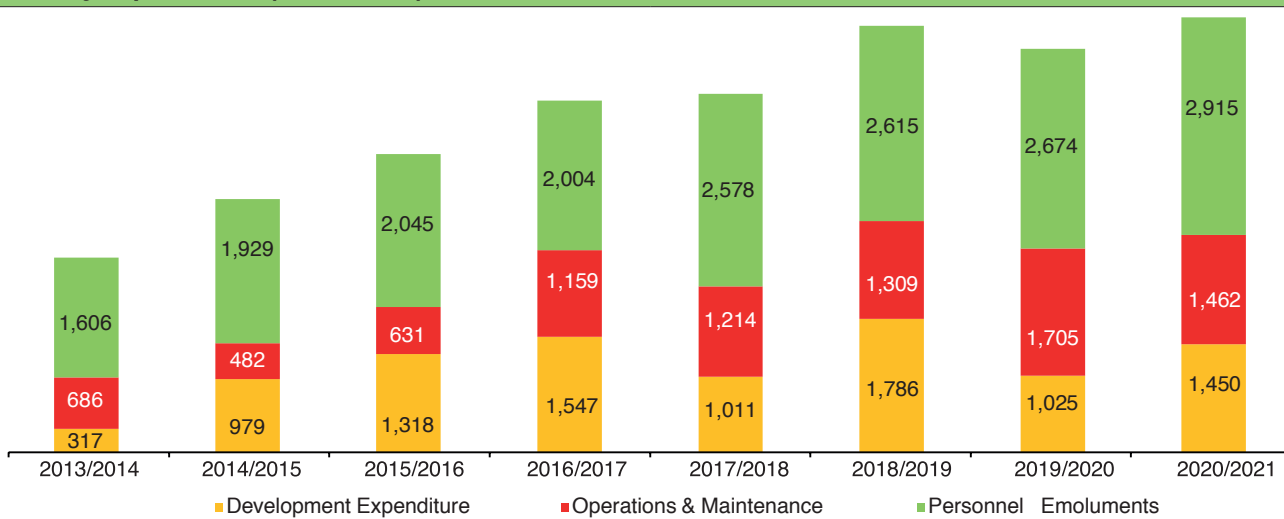
Percent of Population Engaged in Economic Activities by Sector as at 2015/16

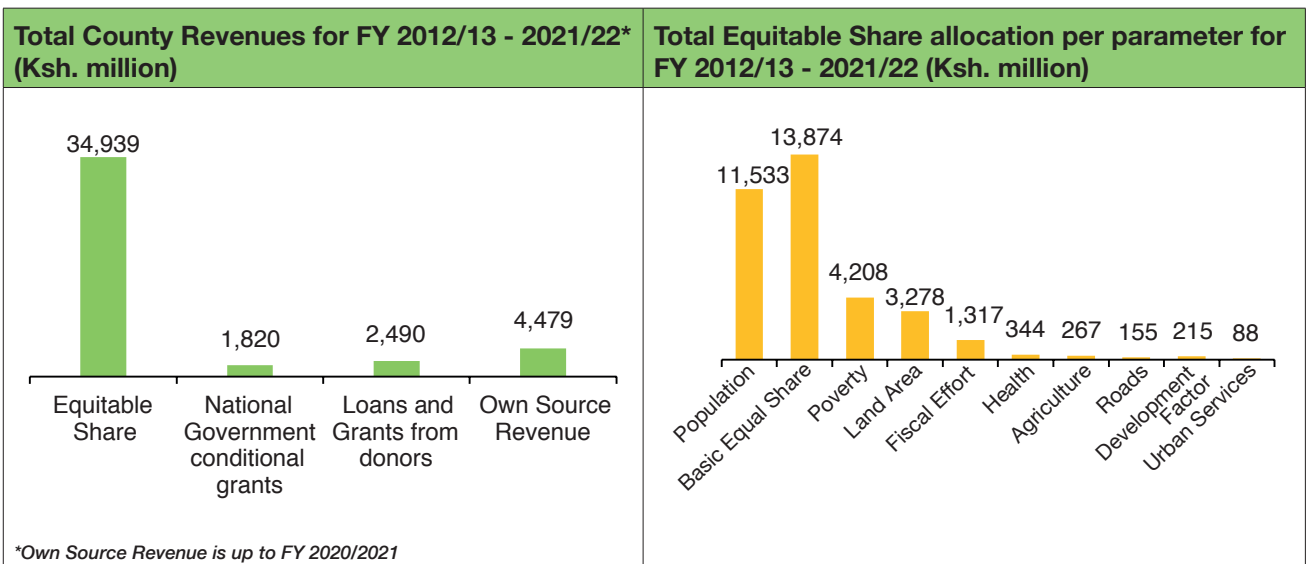
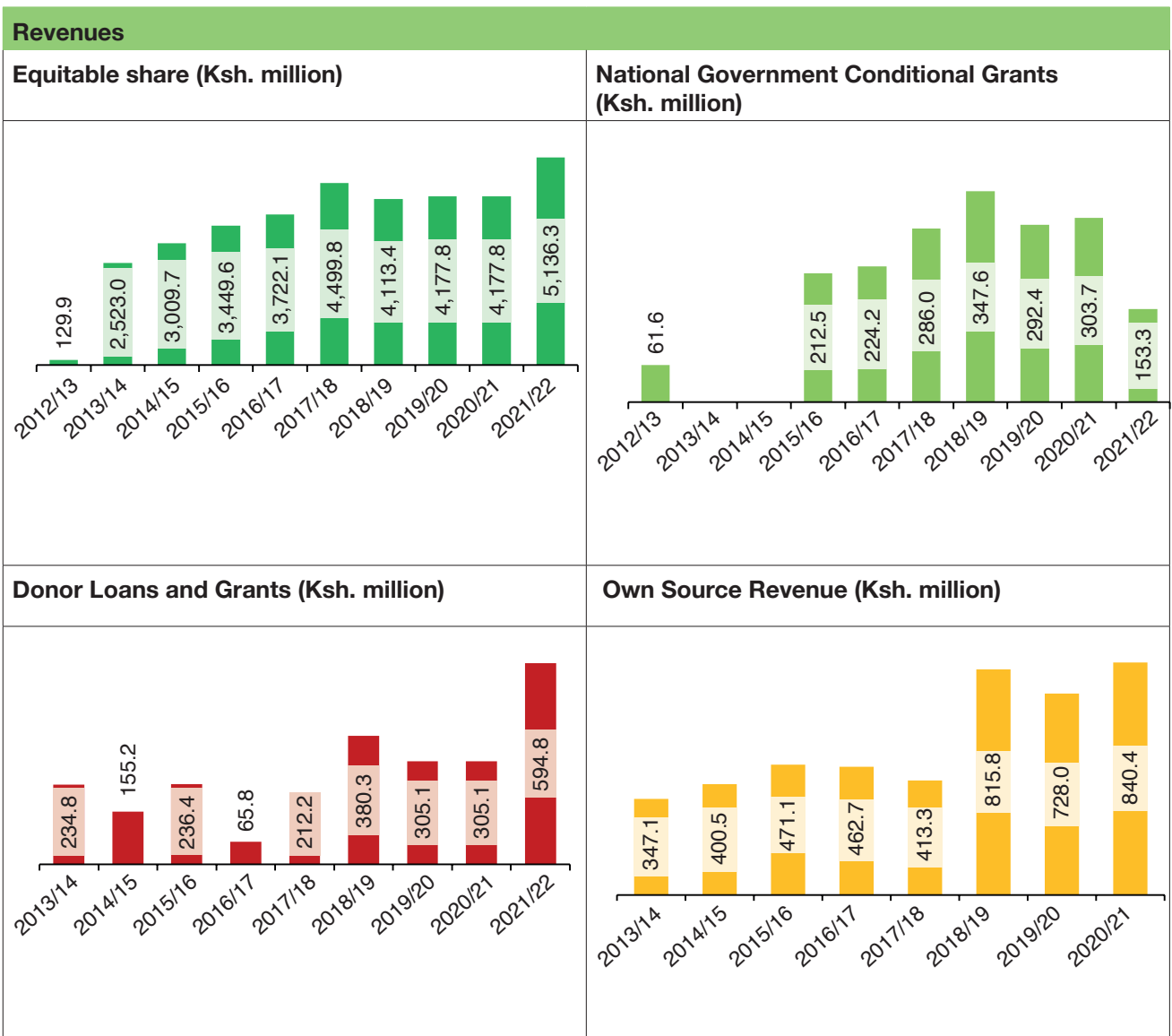


Households engaged in farming activities
